What is PSACLN? (AKA CLN)

The Caregiver Learning Network is comprised of representatives from all caregiver support agencies across BC. OFPA and two other support agencies in BC recognized the need for additional and accessible caregiver education. Through collaboration with MCFD and a lot of hard work, CLN can now offer effective and meaningful learning opportunities to Caregivers.

CLN develops free virtual learning opportunities to Foster Caregivers, Kinship Care Providers and contracted Agency Caregivers. CLN enhances caregiver knowledge, skills and abilities, and helps to foster a healthy caregiving network.
